



### Integrating the Calendar into your site:

EzTix events calendar can be easily integrated into your own website! This generic calendar design is generated using JavaScript and can be styled by your web master using CSS. (See instructions below for styling instructions)

**Step 1:** Log into your organizer control panel, click on the Global Settings tab. Click on the Calendar button to view the auto generated calendar code. Copy the code from the first box into the head tag of the page.

**Step 2:** Next, inset the line of code from the second box into the area of the page where you want the calendar to display. By default the calendar will expand to fit the element that is placed in, you can change this behaviour by editing the CSS (see below).

### Styling the calendar using CSS:

This is to be done by your web master or programmer:

**Step 1:** Download the calendar CSS file from <http://www.eztix.co/css/sbcal.css> and modify it as needed to change fonts and colours for your site. It is very important to not remove any tags, as the calendar may not load. Use the file as a guide and just change what needs to be changed.

**Step 2:** Once you have change the file to meet your needs, install the file on the server hosting the website.

**Step 3:** Change the JavaScript line at the top of the calendar page to point at the new CSS file on the server that you have just modified rather than the one on our site.

**Tip:** Use a tool such as Firebug in Firefox to examine the calendar HTML that is generated, to get an idea of which tags go where.
